Please can we remind you as the weather gets warmer that if you wish to send your child with a sun hat or a drinks bottle, please ensure that they are clearly labelled. Try to send your child with water only. as we are a healthy school and we learn all about how water is so good at keeping us hydrated. Please also ensure that you have applied sun-cream to your child when necessary, before coming to school.

Each week the children will be taking part in many speaking and listening activities. Beginning on Mondays the children will have the chance to share about their weekend and listen to what their friends have been doing too. You could support your child by talking about their weekend before they come to school at the start of the week, to help them to remember something they have done and want to share with their friends.

For our reading this term we will be focussing on developing early reading behaviours and a love of books and reading. With this in mind each week the children will have the opportunity to bring home a school library book to share with family and friends. These books will enable the children to experience a range of exciting and interesting stories and texts. Please continue to record these shared reading times in their reading diary, to build towards our reading party at the end of the term. In addition to this each week we will have a focus book upon which we will base much of our learning and adult led activities. There will also be a daily story time where children get the chance to enjoy a story of their choice.



Please can we ask again that the children do not bring with them any special or valuable toys or wear any valuable clothing to school. We do have messy play every day and the children are inevitably going to get messy and dirty when accessing it. Also, we have noticed an increase in children bringing their own toys from home. Although we always endeavour to keep them safe, it is very upsetting if special toys get lost. Please ensure your child just brings a "comfort" toy as necessary; this will hopefully reduce the number of lost items.
