PROJECT

This term our project will be 'You are what you eat'. We will be learning about how food grows (this will include a trip to the allotment!), where food comes from and how to assemble and cook ingredients. Our aim will be to design and make a pizza in design and technology and write a set of instructions on how to do it. In art we will be learning how to sketch and mix colours. As part of our computing curriculum we will be learning programming using scratch.

PE

We will be looking at how to add suffixes to root words and consolidating skills that the children have learned so far this year.

Children will be given weekly spellings and will be tested each Thursday. Spellings will be linked to the children's phonics groups.
