Spellings are handed out once per week and taught within school. The Year 4 curriculum is based on consolidating Year 3 word lists and ensuring the children know how to use them effectively and correctly. Children will be tested on a regular basis (not necessarily each week). We will pay close attention to see if they are applying what they have learnt in their writing.
